Vote Descriptions

- 1) Woman's Right to View Act: H. 248 would require a doctor to inform a woman that she has a right to view an ultrasound before performing an abortion on here. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Result: Passed 25-9. Sponsor: Rep. Janice McGeachin (R-Idaho Falls)
- 2) North American Union: HJM 5 was a Joint Legislative Memorial urging Congress to oppose any efforts that would lead to the creation of North American Union. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Result: Passed 24-10. Sponsor: Rep. Jo An Wood (R-Rigby)
- 3) English as Official Language: S 1172 makes English the official language of government and recognizes its importance in creating a common culture. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Result: Passed 20-15 Sponsor: Senator Mel Richardson (R-Idaho Falls)
- 4) Film Industry Corporate Welfare: S 1156 would set aside \$1 million to provide a 20% rebate to those who make "qualified media productions" in Idaho. Given that this isn't the role of government (nor an efficient method of economic development), The Idaho Conservative's Position is: No. Result: Passed 23-12 Sponsor: Senator Robert Geddes (R-Soda Springs.)
- 5) Smoking Ban in Bowling Alleys-Vote to Override Governor Otter's Veto of H. 121, which would ban smoking in all bowling alleys in Idaho. As this violates private property rights, The Idaho Conservative Position is No. Passed 29-6 Sponsor: Rep. Bob Ring (R-Caldwell.)
- 6) Parental Consent for Abortion: S. 1082 requires parental consent before an abortion is obtained. The Idaho Conservative Position is "Yes." Passed 23-12 Sponsor: Senator Russ Fulcher (R-Meridian)
- 7) Benefits for Illegal Aliens: S. 1157 requires verification of legal status to receive public benefits except in emergencies. The Idaho Conservative Position is "Yes." Passed 29-6. Sponsor: Senator John McGee (R-Caldwell.)
